Dear business partners,

The POP Regulation sets out detailed requirements regarding the production, placing on the market, use and release of persistent organic pollutants (POPs) in the EU. The regulation implements the Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants, which the EU joined, and the UNECE POP Protocol. The aim of the regulation is to protect human health and the environment from POPs in accordance with the precautionary principle. It also restricts the release of such substances and lays down provisions for the disposal of waste consisting of, containing or contaminated by such substances.

In 2019, a new version of Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 came into force “for reasons of clarity”, replacing Regulation (EC) No. 850/2004.
