regarding the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986
(California Proposition 65- short name :CP65) here is some information.

The California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act¹ of 1986, published in California Health & Safety Code Section 25249.6, is often referred to simply as “California Proposition 65” or “CP65” for short.

This affects around 900 substances listed by the Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA). These can be carcinogenic and responsible for birth or developmental disorders.

Here are just a few substances from the list:
